## As a matter of law and principle:

• No harassment or discrimination. threat of retaliation, etc.) or verbally). RHF is an equal opportunity employer. RHF and its volunteers respect all people without regard to race, color, religion, creed, age, sex, national origin or ancestry, marital status, veteran status, sexual orientation, or status as a qualified disabled or handicapped individual.

- Disclose conflicts of interest and do not accept personal tips or gifts of anything other than of nominal value.
- Our non-profit status prohibits RHF from engaging in political activities, including promoting candidates or contributions.

RHF affirms the idea of a prompt and fair resolution of all reported breaches in this manner:

- All reports of possible breaches will be treated in confidence as much as possible. If confidentiality cannot be maintained, the individual disclosing the possible breach will be notified.
- Reported breaches will be investigated and, if needed, appropriate action taken based upon the policies of the organization. Retaliation against a person who suspects and reports a breach in good faith will be treated as an independent breach of the Code of Ethics.
